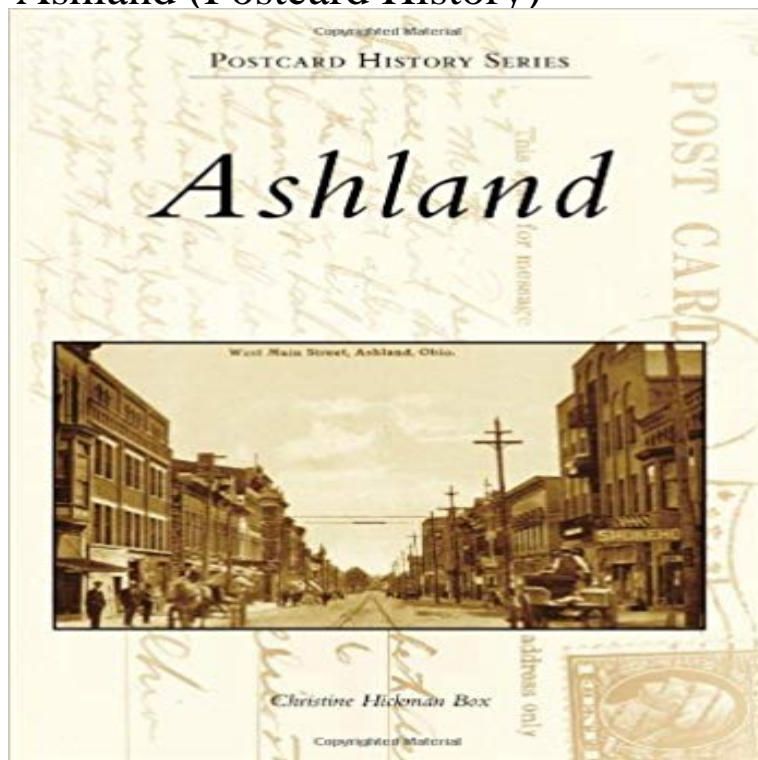


Ashland (Postcard History)
