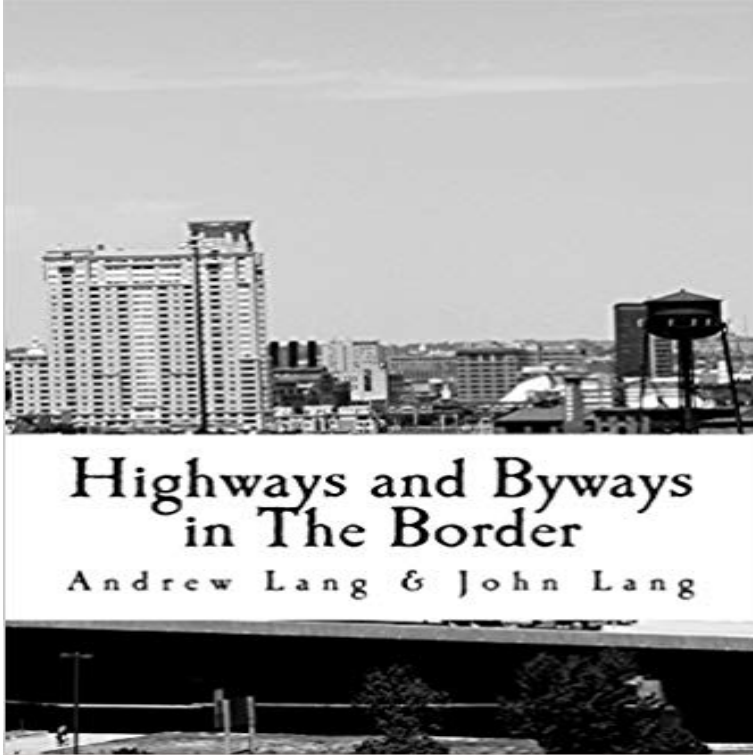


Highways and Byways in The Border
