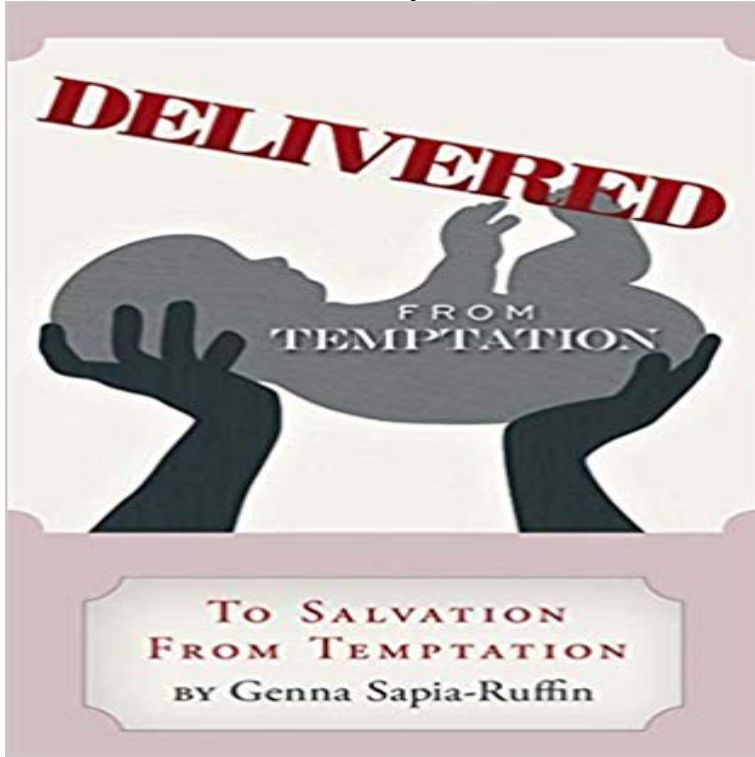


Delivered from Temptation: From Temptation to Salvation
