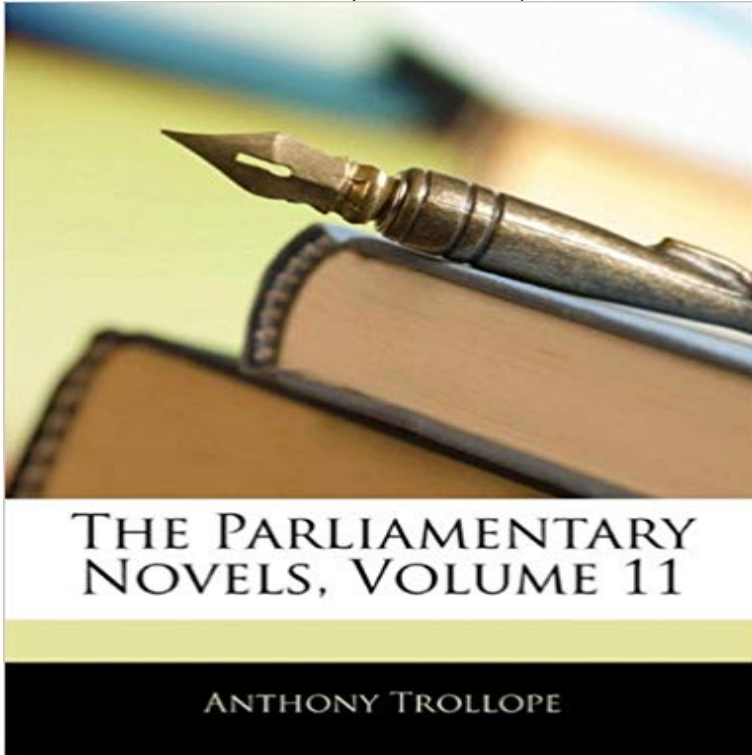


The Parliamentary Novels, Volume 11
