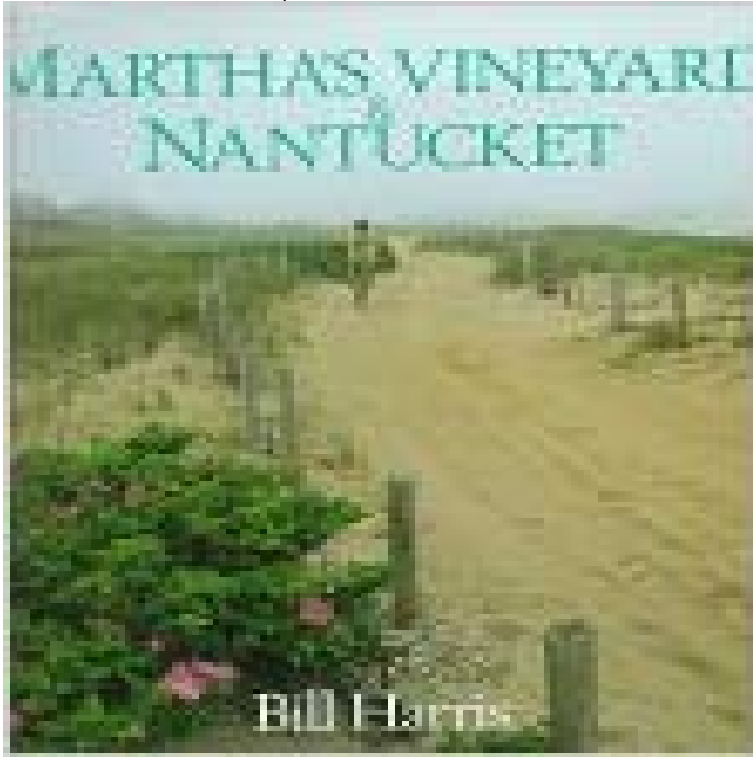


Marthas Vineyard and Nantucket
