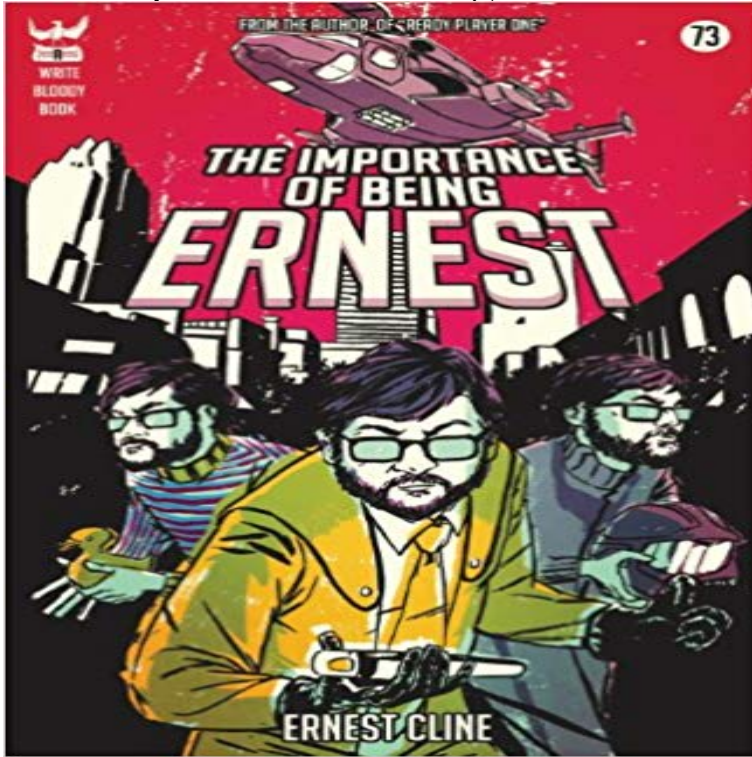


# The Importance of Being Ernest
